### Student Council Report (2023-24)

- October 2023: Everyone was informed to speak in English in the college premises. Indoor sports event named Late Balasaheb Vikhe Patil will be held in the month of February 2024. The In-time for Interns in the hostel is permitted till 9:30pm. Educational Tour for interns will be in the month of January 2024 to Khadki, Pune.
- 3. <u>November 2023</u>: Banner of the student council should be arranged before every meeting. Photos of every meeting should be clicked. Google form should be made for the enrolment of Abhivyakti event. Physiotherapy week and culturals will be conducted in March 2024. PL's for the 1<sup>st</sup> year students were permitted from 5<sup>th</sup> Nov,2023 to the students who were in green zone (attendance more than 75%). The terrace gate of Hostel no.09 will be opened during examination period.
- 4. <u>December 2023</u>: List of students for cultural and sports committee was made under the guidance of respective incharge teacher. Trekking for the 1<sup>st</sup> year fresh batch. Convocation for Interns.
- 7. <u>March 2024</u>: Certificate should be distributed to the participants of E-Wall magazine. Trekking for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> year batch should be planned. Notice board for the cultural event should be made. Education tour for the 3<sup>rd</sup> year batch should be planned. Google link form was made for the registration of the indoor sports event and Academic trophy and there was no entry fees for In College students. Nature's club flyer should be made every month. Health camp should be planned for 3<sup>rd</sup> year batch according to their regular postings. No mobile day flyer should be made. List of 2<sup>nd</sup> year boys should be made for their new aprons and name plate. Tree plantation was planned for 3<sup>rd</sup> year batch for innovations and inventions happened in our college. Cultural event flyer should be released officially on the groups and cultural events notice board.
